KVTA is pleased to announce our Young People's Theatre productions for the 2010-2011 season. We will begin the year with "***Robin Hood, the Musical***". Join Robin Hood and his band of merry men as they joust adventurously thru the Sherwood Forest in Nottingham, England during the reign of King Richard the Lion-hearted. Our second production in the spring is "***Disney's Alice in Wonderland, Jr.***" Alice finds herself beginning a wacky journey down the rabbit hole into a strange land of colorful characters and zany adventures. This fast paced stage adaptation includes new arrangements of classic Disney songs. Both productions will be performed at the Lincoln Cultural Center. There will be a 9:30 a.m. and 12:30 p.m. show each day.

**ROBIN HOOD, THE MUSICAL dates:** Thursday, November 18<sup>th</sup>, 2010 and Friday November 19<sup>th</sup>, 2010

**DISNEY'S ALICE IN WONDERLAND, JR. dates:** Thursday, March 30<sup>th</sup>, 2011 and Friday, April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011

The cost is **\$3.00 for each student, teacher and adult chaperone**. KVTA respectfully requests a limit of 1 chaperone per class. (Special needs will be accommodated) **ALL RESERVATIONS MUST BE PAID IN FULL ONE MONTH PRIOR TO THE PERFORMANCE YOU WILL BE ATTENDING OR YOUR SEATS WILL BE RESOLD TO ANOTHER SCHOOL.** All payments must be made with checks only.

## TO MAKE RESERVATIONS:

We will use the email reservation system again this year. **On Wednesday, September 15<sup>th</sup>, 2010** you may **EMAIL** your reservation to **Sharonkvt@comcast.net** starting at **4:00 p.m.** **We will accept reservations for BOTH shows beginning on September 15<sup>th</sup>.** The email will have the time sent – so please no emails before this date and time. I will be able to process the reservations in the order they are sent.

**This is the information I will need to process your reservation request.**

- 1 - NAME of the SHOW, performance day, date and time.
- 2 – Teacher's name, email address, school phone #, name of school and grade level of students.
- 3 – Total # of reservations (@ \$3.00 each)
- 4 – If wheelchair assistance is needed or hearing and vision impaired students are attending.

Due to the limited seating and the broad appeal of these productions, it is advisable to email as soon as reservations begin. Schools making reservations will be responsible for the seats unless canceled well in advance of the performance date. A confirmation email will be sent to you within five days.

**Important note:** Being one of the first to secure a reservation does not guarantee center front seating. Seating is not done strictly according to order emailed in. There are many other factors involved. Emailing early will only provide you a better chance to get a reservation (our school productions are very popular).
