Victorian designs, English accents, tricky word-play, 7 locations on the black box stage, 44 possible endings...A Man Could Go Quite Mad!! But I was ready to meet it head on.

I want to add a huge round of applause to Nicole Bilyard for taking on the challenge of creating and hand-painting 7 drops for our show. Not to mention the actual set and the portrait of Rosa Bud. The drops alone she started in the summer of 2023 and finished the last one in the first week of January.

I want to thank Aubrey LaLuna for starting our production as our Assistant Director. And a special thanks to Thomas for stepping up when Aubrey unfortunately had to step down. My love and thanks to you both.

I applaud KVTA for embracing the musical and taking a chance on producing it, allowing me to helm the production and the encouragement toward the cast and crew.


